### **Supplement to the Catalog**

The following information updates and replaces certain information set forth in the Saba University School of Medicine Catalog.

#### **Required Documents for Applying (Page 11)**

The next-to-last bullet point should be deleted and replaced with: “MCAT official report (All applicants who are U.S. citizens, nationals or permanent residents are required – and all other students are strongly encouraged – to take the MCAT.)”

#### **Requirements for Graduation (Page 14)**

The following bullet point is added: “Passing scores on the United States Medical Licensing Exam (USMLE) Step 1, USMLE Step 2 Clinical Knowledge and USMLE Step 2 Clinical Skills.”

#### **ECFMG (Page 30)**

The first paragraph should be replaced with the following: “Saba University School of Medicine prepares its students for the practice of medicine. Students should familiarize themselves with the licensure and certification requirements of the jurisdiction(s) in which they may wish to practice. All students are required to sit for and pass the United States Medical Licensing Exam (USMLE) Step 1, USMLE Step 2 Clinical Knowledge and USMLE Step 2 Clinical Skills United States Medical Licensing Exam (USMLE), regardless of whether they intend to practice in the United States. In accordance with the School’s regulatory and accrediting requirements, all students are further required to report their USMLE scores to the School, provide a consent allowing ECFMG to report their scores to the School, and provide a consent allowing the School to report their scores to the School’s regulatory and accrediting bodies.”
