Saba University School of Medicine (SUSOM)

Since 1992, 3500+ aspiring medical doctors have completed our Doctor of Medicine (MD) program. Graduates then go on to hold medical licenses and practice in the U.S., Canada and internationally.

Rooted in our commitment to fostering academic and clinical success, SUSOM students consistently achieve strong USMLE results and postgraduate residency placement rates.

Located on the safe and beautiful island of Saba, students spend the first half of medical school (Basic Science) on campus before transitioning into rotations (Clinical Medicine) in the U.S. (core and electives) and Canada (select electives).

Our accreditor, the Accreditation Organization of the Netherlands and Flanders (NVAO), is recognized by the World Federation of Medical Education (WFME). SUSOM is the only medical school in the Caribbean to meet the rigorous standards of European accreditation. We also hold key state approvals in New York, California and Florida, and are one of the select few Caribbean medical schools authorized to participate in U.S. Title IV federal student loan programs.

Instruction at SUSOM is delivered entirely in English.

About the Island of Saba

Saba is located in the central Caribbean, 28 miles south of St. Maarten. There are daily, direct flights to St. Maarten from the United States and Europe, and multiple flights a day from St. Maarten to Saba. It can also be reached from St. Maarten via a 90-minute ferry ride.

The island, which features a land area of five square miles, has a total population of approximately 2,000 residents. The school has very close ties with the Saban community, with faculty and students often getting involved in local initiatives and events. Residents are also very appreciative of the role that SUSOM plays in supporting the economy and ecosystem protection projects.

Tourists frequently visit Saba for its world-renowned diving, tropical rainforest and safe, relaxing environment. It is the perfect location to deliver impactful medical instruction while benefitting from available tropical activities when it's time to unwind.

Medical University of the Americas (MUA)

Founded in 1998 on the peaceful and secure island of Nevis (Federation of St. Kitts and Nevis), MUA has helped 1,800+ students achieve their Doctor of Medicine (MD) degrees. We consistently provide future physicians with the expansive medical education and individualized support they need to achieve their dreams of a career in medicine.

As part of this commitment, we also offer pre-med and pre-vet pathways – the Master's, 5-year BSc/MD, 6-year BSc/MD and Gateway Medical programs – which help those with different educational and fundamental knowledge levels begin their MD and DVM (at St. Matthew's University School of Veterinary Medicine) journeys. MUA awards Doctor of Medicine (MD), Master of Science (MSc) in Biomedical Science and Bachelor of Science (BSc) in Biomedical Science degrees.

The MUA MD program is accredited by the Accreditation Commission on Colleges of Medicine (ACCM). About the Island of Nevis

Nevis is located in the eastern Caribbean, two miles from St. Kitts and accessible by air via connecting flights from San Juan, Antigua, St. Maarten or St. Kitts. Most visitors first fly to St. Kitts, and then travel to Nevis via ferry or water taxi across The Narrows (approx. a 20-minute ride).

Nevis, also called the "Paradise Island," is 36 square miles in area with a population of approximately 12,000 residents. It is a safe island, conducive to academic focus, family life and recreation.

Much of Nevis slopes gently down from a 3,000-foot mountain peak to the palm fringed, silver sand beaches, coconut groves and turquoise sea. The island has a pleasant climate with an average annual temperature of 79° Fahrenheit (26°C). Humidity is low and regular northeast trade winds keep the island cool.

The capital of Nevis is Charlestown. The twin-island federation of St. Kitts and Nevis gained its independence from the United Kingdom in 1983, but still remains a member of the British Commonwealth.

Only 480 miles from Miami, Florida, 50 miles south of Cuba, and 180 miles northwest of Jamaica, the island is easily accessible. There are at least 55 flights per week entering Grand Cayman and 28 from Miami alone. Major carriers such as Cayman Airways, American Airlines, Jet Blue, United, Delta, Southwest, WestJet and Air Canada offer direct flights from major cities, including Chicago, Toronto, New York, Charlotte, Atlanta, Houston, Tampa and London.

The Cayman Islands' remarkable success as a financial center and tourist destination has transformed the nation into a dynamic society that has every modern convenience but still retains the charm and vibrancy of the Caribbean. People from more than 100 countries live and work in this British Overseas Territory, creating a lively and unique blend of cultures.

Our Doctor of Veterinary Medicine (DVM) degree program allows students to graduate in just over three years, after 2+ years on welcoming Grand Cayman (learn about our island home in the preceding SMUSOM section) in the Basic Sciences program, and then one year of Clinical Medicine rotations at an affiliated veterinary school in the U.S., Canada or the United Kingdom. DVM participants also benefit from early hands-on training and unique access to exotic species, as well as more standard large and small animals.

Thanks to our strong curriculum, dedicated faculty and individualized support services, students achieve success in the NAVLE exam and go on to practice in the U.S., Canada and internationally.

SMUSVM is recognized by the American Veterinary Medical Association (AVMA) and is a Provisional Member Institution of the American Association of Veterinary Medical Colleges (AAVMC).
